

Eco-village project, Katewadi, Taluka Baramati, District Pune, Maharashtra, India

Under 'Katewadi Eco-village' project, Ecosan Services Foundation (ESF) has been assigned the task of providing sustainable solution for sanitation facilities and wastewater generated in different community locations.

Toilets attached to a decentralized treatment system have already been constructed in the primary school and have been proposed facilities for bus stand and public health care centre for the users.

The three locations are:

1. Primary school: The toilets and treatment system is designed for 370 students and staff members.

Such sanitation projects help to develop positive attitude towards wastewater management systems in the children and the authorities' in-charge. This completed school project is one step in the entire '**Katewadi, eco-village**' project.

2. Bus stand: The toilets and treatment system is designed for wastewater generated from 400 to 500 commuters daily.

3. Public Health Care Centre: The facilities are designed for wastewater generated from 10 people daily.

Apart from that IEC strategy focusing to sustainable sanitation and reuse of resource oriented approach This is an on-going project. The project will help to promote the Ecosan concept in the village.
